We are excited that your child will be joining us for the 2023-2024 school year at Shoemaker Elementary. Below is a suggested supply list that will help your child be prepared for Kindergarten. You may bring your supplies at orientation.

Individual Student Suggested Supply list for the year:

1 pencil box—hard plastic or metal 2 packs of 12 count sharpened #2 pencils

1 pack of eraser caps

6 packs of 24 count Crayola crayons

1- 1 subject spiral notebook 1 pair of scissors

12 alue sticks

4 BLACK fine tip dry erase markers (these are the size of a pencil, not the fat ones) to be used at student's desk on an individual dry erase board

1 pair of headphones in a <u>labeled</u> Ziploc bag (no ear buds please)

No nap mat needed!
