Individualized virtual learning for medical fragile students or as requested by parents.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Division led instruction via Virtual Virginia and Edgenuity • Grades assigned to assignments • One a student enrolls in virtual, they must complete the semester in virtual • Students who attend onsite classes may at any time enroll for Virtual. But once they begin Virtual, they need to complete the semester before returning to onsite. 	

Parents Have Options

Return to School

- Students will currently return to school under Plan C. PreK-3, Special Education and EL students may return for in-person instruction. All other students 4-12th grade are REMOTE learning.
- Parents may request anytime for a student to move to the virtual option.
- If the Governor moves Virginia to Phase 1, all students will go to REMOTE learning under Plan D.

100% Virtual

- Students in Preschool - 12th grade can choose virtual learning.
- Students will receive a Chromebook and applicable textbooks/resources.
- K-5 Classes will be enrolled in SCPS Elementary Virtual School
- 6-12 Classes will be enrolled in Edgeunity
- Once enrolled in the virtual school program it is required for the entire semester.

Health Screening

Staff:

- Required to perform self-check (temperature and symptoms) prior to reporting to school daily
- Required to document and retain Self-Check Monthly Forms

Students:

- Parents should take their child's temperature and check for symptoms prior to reporting to school daily (Daily check form was sent home for your student)
- Temperatures will be taken daily upon arrival to school at either the car or bus.

Arrival

- **Morning Drop-off Time: 7:05 - 8:25**
- **Tardy Bell/School Begins: 8:25**
- Drop-off locations are at the front of the building for students PreK-6th and students in 4th-6th may also be dropped off at the bus garage/blacktop area as well.
- Staff will meet your child at your vehicle for a temperature screening.
- **Students who arrive between 7:05-7:30 will report directly to the cafeteria where a teacher will assist them.**
- **Students who arrive 7:30-8:20 will go directly to their classroom.**
- Parents of young children who are beginning school for the first time may walk their child to the main door and a staff member will assist your child to class.
- If your child arrives tardy to school, please ring the doorbell and a staff member will meet you at the door to sign your child in to school.

Dismissal

- **1:15 - Early dismissal is available for PreK and Kindergarten students only.** Students may be picked up at the bus garage/blacktop playground area. The first car in line needs to begin the line up at the yellow line.
- **1:30 - Bus riders** will be called by bus number to begin loading buses.
- **1:45 - Buses leave Shoemaker for GCMS/GCHS**
- **1:55 - Car riders** will be called out by grade level.
- **3:00 - Faculty Dismissal Bell**
- Parents who need to check out students early should call the school prior to arrival. Once you arrive please ring the doorbell at the main entrance and a staff member will meet you at the door to sign your child out. Please do not enter the building.
- **If at all possible, call Shoemaker no later than 12:30 if your child needs to follow a different afternoon dismissal routine (386-7002).**
- **If you know ahead of time, please send a written note and email their teacher as well.**

Breakfast and Lunch

- **ALL STUDENTS RECEIVE ONE FREE BREAKFAST MEAL AND ONE FREE LUNCH MEAL.** Students will need to pay for extra food if they want extras.
- Breakfast will be a Grab-N-Go breakfast for students to eat in the classroom.
- Students will eat lunch in their classroom. We will try to eat in the cafeteria if time and space permits on a rotating basis.
- **No outside food can be delivered to faculty, staff, or students.**

Safety Measures

- Face coverings will be worn when social distancing of 6 feet isn't feasible.
- Social Distancing
- 2 Clinics Available - Well Clinic and Sick Clinic
- Students with a temperature of 100 or higher will be sent home.
- Visitor Restrictions
- Assigned Seating
- Students will only ride assigned bus
- Trainings
- Cleaning Measures
- No commonly shared areas in the classrooms

- Covid19 cases will occur, and schools may have to close.
- Be ready for Plan D: Remote Learning to be implemented at any time.
